San Diego IRWM Updates Prop 50 Contract Administration

- RWMG has improved the Prop 50 grant administration structure
 - To streamline administration, SDCWA will contract directly with all local project sponsors
 - SDCWA is hiring a new "grant administrator" to manage quarterly invoicing and reporting
 - Project sponsors will eventually use web-based software for invoicing and reporting

San Diego IRWM Updates Watershed Planning and Outreach Workgroup

- Completed Workgroup activities:
 - Developed a policy proposal on the role of watershed groups in IRWM planning
 - Reviewed and contributed to the online project database
- · Ongoing activities:
 - Developing a Prop 84 Project Guide to be distributed to watershed groups, DACs, and other stakeholders
 - Preparing a DACs Outreach Strategy

San Diego IRWM Updates Watershed Planning and Outreach Workgroup Watershed Policy Proposal • Eliminate "San Diego Integrated Watershed Coalition" as a long-term institutional structure alternative (IRWM Plan Section G.2) • Add "Watershed Group Involvement" as a core component • Encourage the formation of watershed coordination groups where they do not presently exist • Identify one watershed coordination group – or coalition if many exist – to represent each hydrologic unit

San Diego IRWM Updates Watershed Planning and Outreach Workgroup

- Add "Watershed Group Involvement" as a core component (cont.)
 - Encourage watershed groups to collaborate with other water management entities on well-integrated projects
 - Allow watershed groups to review IRWM proposals relating to their watershed and provide recommendations for prioritization
 - Solicit input from stakeholders where groups do not eviet
 - Use watershed plans as inputs for the IRWM Plan Update

San Diego IRWM Updates AB1420 Compliance

Who must comply?

- Requires that grants or loans made to urban water suppliers by DWR, SWRCB, or California Bay-Delta Authority be conditioned on implementation of water conservation BMPs.
 - Urban water suppliers serve >3,000 customers or >3,000 acre-feet per year.
- Applies to funds made available through DWR's IRWM Program, including the upcoming Proposition 84 grant cycle.

San Diego IRWM Updates AB1420 Compliance

What does compliance mean?

- Implementation of the 5 BMPs (formerly 14 BMPs) described in the California Urban Water Conservation Council (CUWCC) MOU:
 - Utilities Operations Programs
 - Education Programs
 - Residential BMPs
 - Commercial/Industrial/Institutional BMPs
 - Landscape BMPs

San Diego IRWM Updates AB1420 Compliance

- DWR's compliance documents for AB1420 http://www.owue.water.ca.gov/finance/index.cfm
 - Table 1 is self-certification of BMP implementation
 - Table 2 outlines schedule, budget, and finance plan for implementing outstanding BMPs (within 1 year)
- If opting for FlexTrack or alternative conservation methods, must achieve 18% reduction in "gallons per capita per day" by 2018.




Where do we begin?


- In Compliance: Self-Certify with Table 1 now if your agency is in compliance with BMPs.
- **Not In Compliance**: Self-Certify with Table 2 that BMPs will be implemented soon.
 - Review the CUWCC newly amended 5 BMPs and MOU. www.cuwcc.org
 - Begin developing records documenting BMP implementation.
