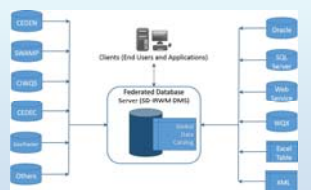

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## Regional Water Data Management Project

- Advisory Workgroup Recommendations:
  1. Decision to Build and Major Steps
    - First step to decide whether or not to build DMS
  2. Potential Project Types
    - Focus on watershed health and sustainability
  3. Governance
    - Establish a small workgroup through RAC
  4. Development of a RFP
  5. Watershed Health and Sustainability (WHS) Evaluation
    - Establish a WHS workgroup through RAC

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## Regional Water Data Management Project

- Potential Next Steps:
  1. Build the Regional DMS
    - Requires local project sponsor
    - Local project sponsor must have an O&M Plan
  2. Continue to Maintain Existing Website and Online System (WaterGIS)
  3. Provide Recommendations to State
    - Federated system with access to multiple databases

- What is the WaterGIS?
  - Existing data management system that provides public access to maps and data specific to the San Diego IRWM Region
  - Data is periodically updated
  - Reflects information and mapping in the IRWM Plan

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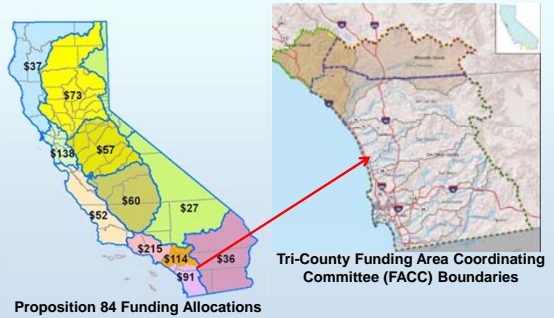

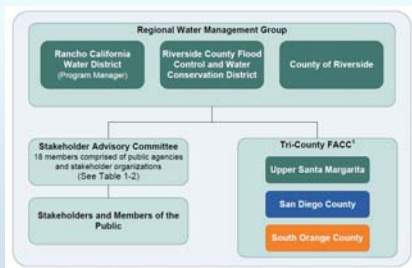

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## Update on Proposition 1

- Planning Grant Funding: \$5 million
  - Statewide competition
  - Likely targeted to regions that do not yet have an adopted IRWM Plan
- DAC Involvement Funding: \$51 million
  - Targeted to efforts to ensure involvement of DACs, economically-distressed areas (EDAs), or underrepresented communities
- DAC Project Funding: \$51 million
  - Targeted to projects that directly benefit DACs

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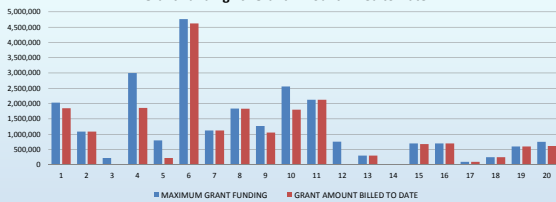
## Proposition 50

- Amendment Requests:
  - Amendment No. 9 Pending DWR approval
  - One new amendment request in Water Authority processing
- Financials:
  - Costs Billed to Date: \$20.8M
  - Outstanding Reimbursements: \$1.1M
- Upcoming:
  - DWR site visits at Carlsbad Local Conveyance Project, Irrigation Giveaway, Cash for Plants retrofit sites, and Ray Stoyer Water Recycling Facility

Grant Funding vs. Grant Amount Billed to Date



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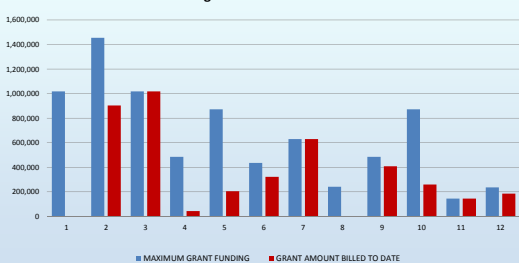
## Proposition 84 Implementation, Rnd 1

- Amendment Requests
  - 4 project amendments submitted and pending DWR approval
- Financials
  - Costs Billed to Date: \$4.1M
  - Outstanding Reimbursements: \$460K
- Upcoming

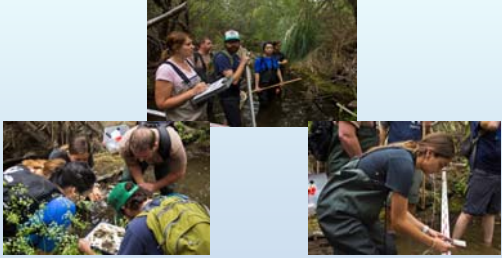

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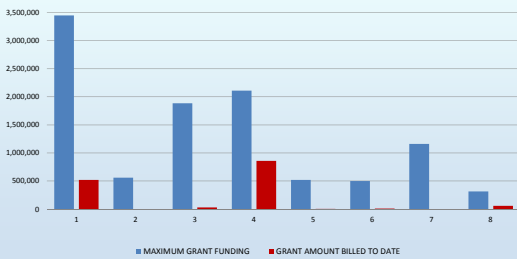
## Proposition 84 Implementation, Rnd 2

- Milestones:
  - Chollas Creek Integration Project, Phase II
    - 90% Pueblo Watershed Assessment completed, grading, permits obtained, outreach conducted, pre-construction activities initiated.
  - Sustaining Healthy Tributaries Project to SD River
    - Hydromodification work and monitoring and education work
  - Rural DAC Project: Pasqual Water Reclaimed Project
    - 80% piping installation complete
- Amendment Requests
  - Three amendment requests pending
- Financials:
  - Costs Billed To Date: \$1.4M of \$10.5M Award
  - Outstanding Reimbursement: \$775K

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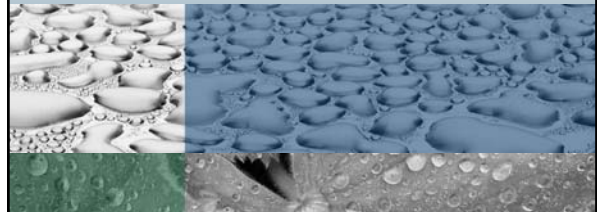
