



## ***Potential San Diego IRWM Mission Statements***

### Option 1

*To develop a strategy that guides local governments, agencies, and entities of the San Diego Region in planning, developing, and managing adequate, reliable, secure, affordable, and sustainable water of suitable quality for all beneficial uses.*

### Option 2

*To implement a strategy that guides the San Diego Region (municipalities, stakeholders, communities, etc) toward managing and developing reliable and sustainable water resources that support all beneficial uses. Through integrated efforts, the Region can identify and resolve water related issues and conflicts and attain equitable resource protection for the entire Region.*

### Option 3

*To develop, implement, and periodically update a comprehensive strategy to effectively coordinate and integrate water supply, water quality, and natural resource planning and management in the San Diego Region. Provide a stakeholder-driven and adaptive management structure in support of this strategy to identify and resolve priority issues and conflicts for the region and its watersheds. Facilitate implementation of identified priorities through increased communication and coordination of efforts, by maximizing opportunities for funding water-related projects, and by advocating for needed programmatic, legislative, and regulatory changes.*

### Option 4

*To achieve the San Diego IRWM goals for successful water management, the mission of the San Diego IRWM Planning effort is to accomplish the following major items:*

- *Establish a **regional stakeholder governance structure**;*
- *Develop and maintain an **IRWM Plan**;*
- *Create a comprehensive integrated **project list** for the IRWM Plan;*
- ***Prioritize** projects and programs for funding;*
- *Secure project **funding** for IRWM Plan implementation;*
- *Provide a **forum for collaboration** on regulatory and legislative issues; and*
- *Provide a **forum to solve** water quality, supply and reliability issues.*

*To implement an integrated strategy that guides the San Diego Region toward protecting, managing and developing reliable and sustainable water resources*
